## Sweatshirt orders

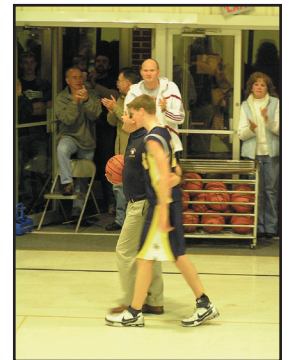
